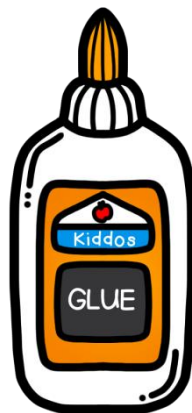
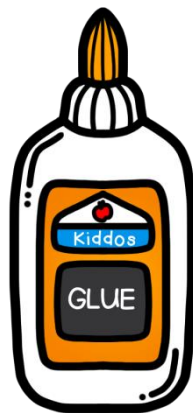
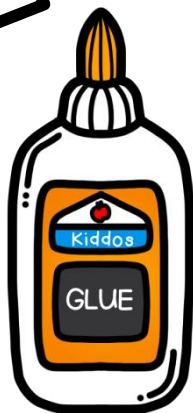


Glued Sounds

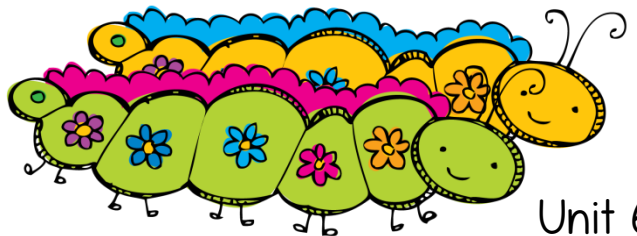

/s/ mops(s) /z/ bugs(s)

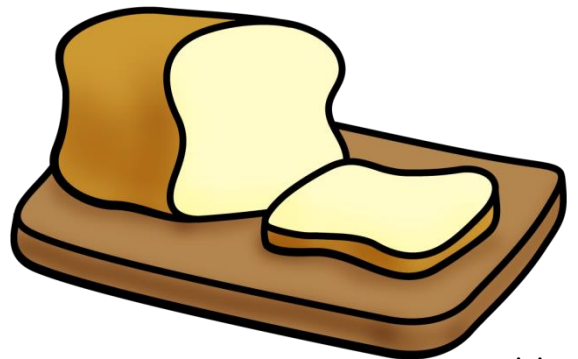


Blend

bl

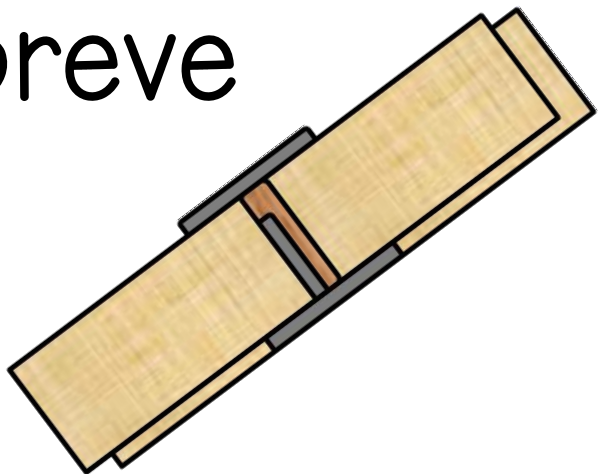
fr



Closed Syllables

- only have 1 vowel
- the vowel is followed by 1 or more consonants
- the vowel sound is short
- the vowel is marked with a breve

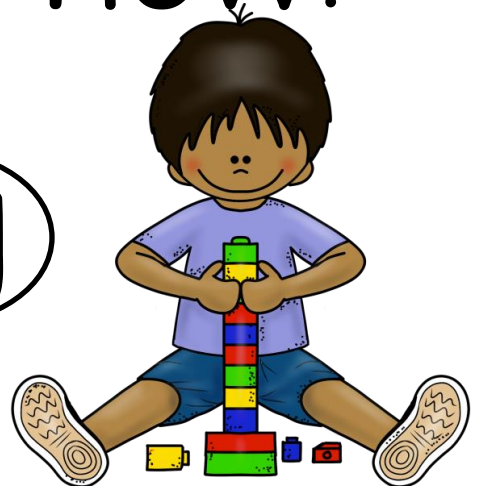


Suffix

-ing

When you add a suffix -ing to verb, it means it is happening now.

He is playing with blocks.

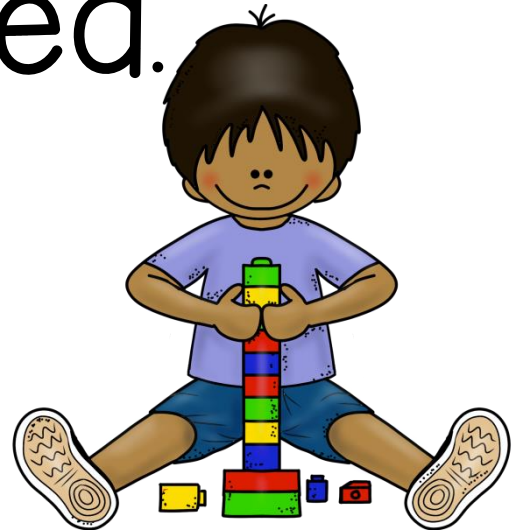


Suffix

-ed

When you add a suffix -ed to verb, it means it already happened.

He played last night.



Silent e

- has a vowel-consonant-e combo
- the e is silent
- the first vowel has a long sound

Suffix -es

Add the suffix /es/ to a base word that ends in s, x, z, /ch/, or /sh/ to make it plural.
